SAMPLE 10 DAY ITINERARY

Day 1 - Arrive at Trinidad (transfer to Hotel) Transportation provided - \$US30 per person

Day 2 – SOUTHERN CIRCLE

Day tour (9 am – 7 pm approx.) to visit the south of Trinidad.

Description: This mix of culture and nature brings you in touch with awe-inspiring Hindu religious attractions and the second largest mangrove wetland in Trinidad – home to the national bird, the Scarlet Ibis. Excursion to include:

- Temple by the Sea
- La Brea Pitch Lake
- Caroni Swamp

Learn about Hindu culture, the asphalt industry, and observe the scarlet ibis in the wild. Cost: US\$150 per person (incl transport, entrance fee, boat fee, guide, & local lunch)

Day 3: TOUR THE ISLANDS

7:30 am pickup

Tour of Gasparee Caves

Description: Take an offshore adventure and descend 100 feet underground to discover this extraordinary cave system filled with stalactites and stalagmites and a crystal-clear salt-water pool at its base that shimmers like glass.

Down the Islands Yacht Cruise with snorkelling and water toys.

Description: Cruise the beautiful waters along the Northwest Coast and Gulf of Paria on a fine Bertram Yacht. Visit and go swimming in enchanting secluded bays only reachable by boat. Relax listening to local music with all the amenities (refreshments, bathroom facilities and air-conditioning). View the islands Gaspar Grande, Monos, Chacachacare as you cruise by. Catch a glimpse of turtles, dolphins and other marine wildlife.

Tour of Nelson Island

Description: Nelson Island is the largest of five miniature islands located in the Gulf of Paria, west of Port of Spain. These islands, rich in history, marine and wildlife and flora, are the Caledonia, Craig, Lenagan, Rock, Pelican and Nelson Islands. Together they are called the Five Islands even though there are six separate isles; Craig and Caledonia Islands are connected by a narrow reef. The group of islands are part of the archipelago that locals refer to as "down de islands" (or DDI).

Cost: US\$150 per person incl transport from hotel, boat, guide, refreshments (finger foods, water & soft



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drinks), entrance fees. Return time: 4pm approx.
*Wet day – bring water shoes, swimsuits, change of clothes, towels.

Day 4 Group to go to Mount St. Benedict and then to Asa Wright 3:15 pm: pickup from Asa Wright, back to the hotel.

Description: Half-day trip to the world-renowned Asa Wright Nature Centre in the lush green Northern Range. Travellers will discover the impressive mix of birds, mammals, reptiles and butterflies and take a swim in cool mountain water.

Cost - \$150 per person – includes Lunch, Guide and Transportation.

Your Tour Guide will provide you with historical and cultural information of the various communities you will be travelling through, from the East and up North to Matura Beach. Witness the Leatherback Turtle Lay its Eggs. At the beach, you will be taken by a specialist site guide to see the Leatherback Turtles as they arrive nightly to lay their eggs.

Cost: US\$ 150 per person.

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Easy hike to gorgeous waterfall A two-hour drive along the scenic North Coast past Maracas & Blanchisseuse will bring us to the starting point of our hike: a tiny village in the remote rainforest.

The Hike is easy & beautiful and takes approx.3/4-hour one way. We hike along and inside a shallow river to the most amazing waterfall of approx. 65 ft, with a large plunge pool (see photo) for bathing. After some relaxing time and a nice head-massage from the falls, we return to the base. We then drive to popular Maracas Beach for a delicious Bake & Shark sandwich (incl. in cost) and another swim (optional).
