

Circuit Tadrart Magic Trek

08 Days / 07 Nights



Come and discover one of the most beautiful deserts of the Sahara through this superb hike: the Tadrart, a series of mineral landscapes will transport you to a world of unreal imaginary forms.

During your hike, you will discover the red dunes of the Tadrart which offers one of the most fantastic landscapes of the Sahara as well as many cave paintings. La Tadrart is located southeast of Djanet, capital of Tassili N'ajjer.

It will be a permanent spectacle of a mixture of rocks and colored sand with glowing reflections.



Special features :

- **The 4x4 transfer to the Tadrart with the discovery of the great outdoors and the legendary mountain of Tiska**
- **Arrival via the In Djaren wadi**
- **The magnificent dunes with its red sand of the Tadrart**
- **Rock paintings and engravings (- 4000 years old) from the time when elephants, giraffes and rhinos were living there**
- **The ascent of one of the highest dunes in the region : Tin Merzouga and its exceptional panoramic view over the Tadrart**
- **The different reliefs with strange shapes, animals...**

Day 1 Saturday: Arrival to Algiers, transfer to Algiers national airport (200 m)

Then Flight Algiers 11 p.m. - Djanet 1:15 a.m. (Sunday).

Welcome at Djanet airport by our Tuareg guide and our team.

Transfer to the agency's guest house to spend the night.

Day 2 Sunday: Via Oued In Djaren, arrival in Tadrart and to start the hike with the discovery of the first site of cave paintings. Very nice walks to arrive at Moul Naga in the evening. Bivouac and overnight

Day 3 Monday: First hikes and walks in the Injaran Canyons, to visit cave paintings and engravings. Lunch in the cathedral arches (Tamisguida in Touareg) bivouac in the dunes of Moulénagua.
We will also pass by Bouhadian, before discovering the Tiska circus, the hedgehog-shaped rock called in Touareg Ekenesseï and many other extraordinary places. Bivouac.

Day 4 Tuesday: Hike to cross the big dunes of moul-nagua. Arrival at noon in Inzaouatan. Lunch then afternoon walk. Bivouac at Intehak, next to Africa Geography Map Ark



Day 5 Wednesday: Direction the dunes of Tinmerzougua, passing by the guelta bouhadiane visit the varied landscapes and the hedgehog rock called in Touareg Ekenessei and many others extraordinary places. Bivouac in the large dunes of Timerzougua.

Day 6 Thursday: Passage by the Monimum (world cup) and the natural corridor circus of the Tadrart, lunch in Ouanaguan, bivouac in the evening at Tissetika.

Day 7 Friday: Way back to Djanet, passage by the mountain of Tiska,, the dunes of erg Admer, visit of the "crying cow", visit the palm grove and its market with its fabrics. Shower in the Moorish bath and transfer to the agency's guest house for one last night.

Day 8 Saturday: Transfer to the airport for Djanet flight at 4:15 a.m.
Arrive Algiers at 6:30 a.m., then head to the international airport for a return flight.

Payment policy

- Deposit payment of 30 % at the confirmation
- Balance payment 01 month before departure

Cancellation policy

- 0 % until 45 days before departure
- 30 % until 30 days before departure
- 50 % until 15 days before departure
- 100 % less than 15 days before departure
