### **TOUR DESCRIPTION**

### Day 1: Quito: Arrival & Briefing with Your Guide

Land at Quito International Airport. Transfer to your hotel on your own (see "Transfer Options"). Afternoon at leisure. Briefing with your guide at the hotel.

Meals not included. Overnight at your hotel in Quito.

### Day 2: QUITO (→) BALTRA –GALAPAGOS: Highlands of Santa Cruz / PUERTO AYORA

#### Breakfast at the hotel.

Arrive on the Galapagos by plane and transfer to the airport on Baltra Island. Cross the Itabaca Channel, and on the other side, a bus will take you to the highlands of Santa Cruz to visit the Giant Tortoises Reserve.

Transfer to Puerto Ayora and check in at the hotel. Meals not included. Overnight at your hotel in Puerto Ayora.

### Day 3: SANTA CRUZ ISLAND: Full Day Navigation to One of: Bartolome, North Seymour, South Plaza, Santa Fe

Breakfast at the hotel.

According to the boat's availability, we will sail to one of these islands:

**North Seymour** was elevated from the seabed by volcanic activity, which gives it a flat and low profile. The elevations are a few meters above the coast, where the swallow-tailed gulls perch on the cliff. A small endemic Palo Santo forest rises near the landing site.

**Bartolome Island** is famous for Pinnacle Rock, a triangular rock that rises from the shores of the sea and is the best-known symbol of the islands. The Galapagos penguins walk on rocks and volcanic edges, and sea lions rest on rocky platforms ready to slide into the water to play with those who swim or practice surface diving.

**South Plaza** is a small island full of fascinating natural life at the edge of the sea and on the cliffs: sea lions, land iguanas, swallow-tailed gulls, and Opuntia cacti.

**Santa Fe** offers one of the most beautiful and protected bays of the islands. Like North Seymour, this island was elevated from the seabed by a seismic event and you can see the underwater lava formations.

Lunch or bag lunch included. Overnight at your hotel in Puerto Ayora.

### Day 4: SANTA CRUZ ISLAND: Speed Boat to ISABELA: Wetlands Excursion

Breakfast at the hotel.

Early morning departure to Isabela Island via public speedboat (approx. travel time 2 1/2 to 3 hrs.)

A guide will greet you in Puerto Villamil and guide you to check in at the hotel.

After a brief rest, take a short walk to visit the Flamingo Lagoon, one of the natural breeding sites of the Galapagos flamingos. We'll also visit the Giant Tortoises Breeding Center.

Meals not included. Overnight at your hotel in Isabela.

### Day 5: ISABELA ISLAND: Half-Day Tintoreras Tour & Afternoon Snorkel at Concha Perla

Breakfast at the hotel.

Las Tintoreras is an islet located south of Puerto Villamil, and you can spot sea lions, sea turtles, marine iguanas, and rays along its turquoise bay. When the tide is low, you can see reef sharks swim alongside other small fish and sea lions. Las Tintoreras is one of the few places where iguanas breed successfully because of the absence of non-native animals that could otherwise hurt them.

In the afternoon, visit Concha de Perla, a natural pool ideal for swimming and snorkeling in with sea lions, marine iguanas, and a wide range of fish. It's recommended to visit during low tide for better visibility and is advisable to use fins when entering or exiting the water. **Meals not included.** Overnight at your hotel in **Isabela.** 

### Day 6: ISABELA ISLAND: Speed Boat to SANTA CRUZ: Charles Darwin Station Visit

Breakfast at the hotel.

Early in the morning transfer by speed boat to Santa Cruz Island, Arrive and check in at your selected hotel.

In the afternoon, visit the Charles Darwin Research Station and learn about its research and conservation programs. Observe giant tortoises in captivity, as well as land and marine iguanas.

Meals not included. Overnight at your hotel in Puerto Ayora.

### Day 7: BALTRA -GALAPAGOS (+) QUITO Arrival in Quito & Transfer to Hotel

### Breakfast at the hotel.

You will be picked up from the hotel according to your flight schedule. You will then embark on a ferry to cross the Itabaca Channel to Baltra Island, where a public bus will drop you off at the airport.

Arrive in Quito. Transfer to your hotel. Meals not included.

### Day 8: QUITO: City Tour & Middle of the World / OTAVALO

### Breakfast at the hotel. City tour.

Start at the historical center of the city and visit UNESCO World Heritage designated churches and monasteries. See Independence Square, the Presidential Palace, the Cathedral, the Archbishop's Palace and City Hall. Stroll past El Sagrario Church and marvel at the exquisite stone façades and interiors of La Compañía.

Visit Church of San Francisco and ride to the top of Panecillo Hill to see a breathtaking view over Quito.

Then journey towards the Equator Line, designated by a monument and an ethnographic museum 22 kms from Quito.

Transport to the North of Ecuador - Otavalo. Meals not included. Overnight at your hotel in Otavalo.

### Day 9: OTAVALO: Artisanal Local Market & Return to Quito (→) Flight Home

### Breakfast at the hotel.

Shop for goods at the colorful market of Otavalo, where you'll find woven rugs, alpaca sweaters, and even agricultural goods. Many of the native merchants still wear their traditional clothes.

Meals not included. On your own, transfer to the airport (see "Transfer Options").

### **PRE – EXTENSION Jungle Lodge**

### Day 1: Quito: Arrival & Briefing with Your Guide

Land at Quito International Airport. Transfer to your hotel on your own (see "Transfer Options").

Afternoon at leisure. Briefing with your guide at the hotel.

Meals not included. Overnight at your hotel in Quito.

### Day 2: QUITO (→) LAGO AGRIO: Arrival & Transfer to the Lodge CUYABENO NATURAL RESERVE

### Breakfast at the hotel.

Morning flight to Lago Agrio. By private bus, journey to the entrance of Cuyabeno River (2 hours) and enjoy a box lunch. Join our naturalist guide on a two-hour tour on the Cuyabeno River to reach Jamu Lodge. In the afternoon, go for a swim in the lagoon and watch a beautiful sunset in the middle of the Laguna Grande. Return to the lodge for dinner. Spend the night in bungalows with double beds and mosquito nets.

**Dinner included**. Overnight at your lodge in the Cuyabeno area.

### Day 3: CUYABENO NATURAL RESERVE: Jungle Activities

Breakfast at the hotel.

Join your guide for a 3-to-4-hour jungle trek and learn about the complex tropical ecosystem. Hear about medicinal plants and try to spot exotic birds and monkeys. Return to the lodge for lunch and a siesta. In the afternoon, go for a swim in the lagoon and watch sunset. With a little luck, you can see pink river dolphins or an anaconda sunbathing in a tree. Return to the lodge for dinner and take a nighttime canoe ride to look for caimans.

Meals included. Overnight at your lodge in the Cuyabeno area.

### Day 4: CUYABENO NATURAL RESERVE: Jungle Activities

### Breakfast at the hotel.

Depart for the Siona Community of Puerto Bolivar, home to the largest ethnic group in the Reserve. On the way, spot birds, monkeys, snakes, pink dolphins, and tortoises. While touring the Siona Community, learn about their traditions and way of life, and take part in making casaba, a local dish of yucca. Then return to the lodge and go on a night hike in the forest in search of insects, geckos and scorpions while listening to the sounds of the jungle.

Meals included. Overnight at your lodge in the Cuyabeno area.

## **Day 5: CUYABENO NATURAL RESERVE:** Transfer to Lago Agrio Airport - (→) **QUITO**. Arrival and transfer to hotel for program start

Early this morning before breakfast, join an optional bird-watching excursion. Enjoy breakfast at the lodge and journey back upstream on the Cuyabeno River. The bus will take you to Lago Agrio. Return to Quito.

Arrival in Quito. Transfer into your hotel.
