## II. ITINERARY

### DAY 1

### SIEM REAP

In the morning enjoy a half day bicycle tour and explore the side of Cambodia only few people see. Cycle through quiet back-trails along the picturesque & friendly Cambodian countryside on the outskirts of Siem Reap. Witness day-to-day village life and learn a little more about the wonderfully warm people who call it home.

You will start with a ride along the Siem Reap River, then leave the tarmac and ride on small dirt paths through the scenic countryside and friendly villages. We will see palm wine and sugar production, rice farming and all sorts of activity that keeps the countryside buzzing along. We stop for some unique Cambodian snacks and then make tracks and trails back to the town.

### DAY 2

### SIEM REAP – BANTEAY CHHMAR

Banteay Chhmar is approximately a 2.5 hours drive from Siem Reap. Art connoisseurs rave about one of the most impressive temples of the ancient Khmer Empire. After being welcomed by the villagers, you will walk to a first exploration of the temples, which are largely overgrown by nature. Enjoy a picnic lunch then head to the temple for more sightseeing. The entire temple complex is reminiscent of Angkor Thom and the Bayon with its four-faced towers and bas-reliefs.

Spend 2 nights in a safari tent ("Economy Tent" with toilet and washing facilities). Guests can enjoy dinner prepared by the locals.

### DAY 3

### BANTEAY CHHMAR

After breakfast, walk to the local market. You will be accompanied by a Khmer family and a local guide. After purchasing the ingredients, the family home prepares traditional Khmer dishes for lunch. An unforgettable, authentic experience!

In the afternoon we go to the "killing baray". The place is reminiscent of the reign of terror of the Pol Pot regime. The Khmer word Baray stands for an extensive, strictly rectangular water reservoir of the Angkor

period. In Banteay Chhmar, it should be the foundation for the reactionary utopia of an egalitarian village community. Today, not much is reminiscent of this tragedy in the history of Cambodia. Farmers use it as a water reservoir hundreds of years ago. The area also has a rich fauna and flora

Enjoy the ultimate nature retreat and relax in the ambient sounds of rivers and jungle, various of activities like kayaking, boat trip to the water fall or jungle trek will be available at the resort on surcharge
