## HIGHLIGHTS OF CAMBODIA



### Day 1 Phnom Penh

On arrival in Phnom Penh, transfer to your hotel and enjoy free time until your tour briefing. Stay the next two nights at The Sun & Moon Urban Hotel (or similar).

### Day 2 Phnom Penh

Enjoy a morning cyclo ride through the backstreets of Phnom Penh. Discover Wat Phnom, the birthplace of the capital, the Royal Palace and its famous landmark, the Silver Pagoda, and the National Museum with its unique collection of Khmer art. Continue your adventure with a visit to the Toul Sleng Museum, a former High School which became the interrogation and torture facility for the Khmer

Rouge regime, before spending the rest of the afternoon scouring the labyrinth of stalls in the Central Market, selling local silks, crafts and more. (B)

### Day 3 Phnom Penh to Siem Reap

Wake early for your flight to Siem Reap. Transfer to your hotel for check in then enjoy a boat ride to visit the scenic, floating villages of Kampong Phluk. Row through the vast network of flooded mangroves and homes on stilts as you experience local life in this unique and isolated village. Upon your return, enjoy an afternoon of free time in this wondrous city. This evening, enjoy the spectacular and uniquely Cambodian Phare Circus. Stay the next two nights at Steung Siem Reap Hotel (or similar). (B)

### Day 4 Siem Reap

Rise early for your journey to Angkor Wat and admire the breathtaking sunrise over this ancient city. Marvel at the silhouetted central spires and explore the ground before enjoying a local breakfast nearby. Journey onwards to the southern gate of Angkor Thom hosting some of the finest temples and stone carvings including the state temple of Bayon, famous for its stone head sculptures. See the Terraces of the Elephants and the Leper King before continuing your temple exploration with a drive to visit the jungle covered Ta Prohm temple. This evening, enjoy a group farewell dinner. (BD)
