## AQS KENYA REDISCOVERED



### Day 1 Nairobi

Arrival of your International flight at Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport.

You will be met by our airport representative outside customs and immigration halls.

Transferred to **luxury City Hotel** for check-in.

Overnight stay on Bed & Breakfast Basis.

### Day 2 Nairobi - Laikipia

Breakfast and check out of the hotel.

Transferred to Wilson Airport for your morning scheduled flight to Loisaba Airstrip in Laikipia departing at **10h20** to arrive at **11h45**.

On arrival, you will be met by the Loisaba Camp team and transferred to **Loisaba Tented Camp** for check-in.

Afternoon game drive on a shared basis.

Dinner and overnight stay.

### Day 3 Laikipia

Full day spent in the conservancy with shared activities on game package arrangements.

All meals and overnight stay at the Camp.

*(Included: Full board accommodation, soft drinks, beer, house wines & selected spirits, safari activities including day and night game drives, guided bush walks, Location: Loisaba Private Conservancy, Laikipia river rafting and fishing (seasonal), mountain biking, airstrip transfers, laundry & all statutory taxes (approx 25%) including VAT. A 56,000-acre private wildlife conservancy)*

### Day 4 Laikipia - Masai Mara (Mara North Conservancy)

Breakfast at the Camp and check out.

Transferred to the Loisaba Airstrip for your scheduled flight to Masai Mara departing at 09h05 to arrive at 11h00.

Upon arrival, you will be met by the **Kicheche Mara Camp** team and transferred to the Camp for check-in and lunch.

Afternoon game drive on a shared basis.

Dinner and overnight stay.

### Day 5 & 6 Masai Mara Game Reserve (Mara North Conservancy)

Full day spent game-viewing within the conservancy with shared activities on game package arrangements.

All meals and overnight stay at the Camp.

*Included: Full board accommodation, soft drinks, beer, house wines & selected spirits, safari activities including game drives, guided bush walks, airstrip transfers, laundry & all statutory taxes)*

### Day 7 Masai Mara - Nairobi - Lamu Archipelago

Breakfast at the Camp.

Transferred to the airstrip for your scheduled flight to Wilson departing at **11h15** to arrive at **13h00**.

On arrival connect to your scheduled flight to Lamu departing at **14h00** to arrive at **15h10**.

Arrive at Manda Airstrip and transferred by motor boat to **The Majlis Resort** for check in.

Dinner and overnight.

### Day 8 & 9 Lamu Archipelago

Full day spent relaxing at the beach.

Excursions either by boat or on foot can be arranged on optional basis. Boat rides to mangrove forests, visits to neighboring islands and deep-sea fishing expeditions are the favorites.

Enjoy the mysteries of the Old Town and fraternize with the locals.

All meals and overnight at **the resort**.

### Day 10 Lamu - Nairobi

Breakfast and morning spent at leisure.

Early lunch and transferred to Manda Airstrip for your scheduled flight to Wilson departing at **15h40** to arrive at **17h35**. Upon arrival, you will be met by our team and transferred to Jommo Kenyatta International Airport for your International return flight.



## Location and Park Information

### Nairobi

Nairobi is the capital city of Kenya. The largest and most populous city in East Africa, with a current estimated population of about 4.5 million, Nairobi started life as a railway's depot in 1899. Today, the city skyline is dominated by modern high-rise buildings and is a tourism and trade hub. Nairobi is now one of the most prominent cities in Africa politically and financially. ### Laikipia County

To form the conservancy MNC leased land from individual Maasai landowners. This income is fixed and does not fluctuate based on the number of visitors. The idea of guaranteeing a fixed amount marks the first time that these Maasai landowners have received direct, predictable and transparent income from wildlife, allowing community members to plan for the future. Together, MNC and the Maasai are implementing sound land management policies, including managed grazing, holistic management practices, low volume and low impact tourism, and community land-use plans.



## Lamu Archipelago

Lamu is a place like no other, a peaceful tropical island where life is lived at its own relaxed rhythm, but a place whose history is as mysterious and fascinating as the winding streets of its medieval stone town. The island itself is a beautiful place of rolling dunes and endless beaches, where tiny villages nestle among coconut and mango plantations and lateen sailed dhows ply the waters.
