A LA CARTE TOURS

1. Visit a local market + cooking participative class (Private service)

At scheduled time, pick up from your hotel and private transfer to Urban Kitchen, Lima's culinary space for participatory kitchen. It will begin with a tour of the traditional market of San Isidro accompanied by the resident chef. Then, you will learn to cook simply, the different dishes of Peruvian cuisine. Then you will be at the table to enjoy the preparation, blending the experience of a class with a restaurant visit.

The experience includes:

- Visit to a local market.
- Demonstration of a traditional chilcano of pisco preparation.
- Cooking workshop where you will learn to prepare a traditional ceviche, salmon tiradito with ponzu sauce, duo of "causas" (from Lima and Huancayo with prawns) and "lomo saltado".
- Dessert to end the meal. Wines and beers.
- Aprons, which you will keep as gift.
- Recipe notebook with everything learned in class.
- Culinary souvenir (bottle of extra virgin Peruvian olive oil, chocolate, coffee, etc.)

2. Foodies tour Barranco (Private service)

Our experienced and entertaining guides will effortlessly guide you through Barranco, while tasting 8 to 12 different dishes, at some of the 3 best restaurants of the district. You will taste traditional creole food, japanese peruvian nikkei, and some secret fusion places where you will experience firsthand an incredible explosion of flavors. No need to sit in traffic, as we easily walk from one place to another, while enjoying the magical and enchanting ambiance of Barranco. Includes water and 1 pisco sour or chilcano. **Estimated time 2 hours 30 minutes.*

3. Demonstrative cooking class + lunch in Amoramar (Private service)

Pisco sour demonstration

The guests will observe the preparation of our national drink, while the barman shares some tips for the preparation of this drink. Then, the bartender will invite one or two volunteers to come to the bar to prepare their own Pisco Sour. Includes 01 pisco sour per person.

Ceviche

The chef will prepare one of the most representative dishes of our country "Ceviche". During the preparation he will reveal to the guest the best kept secrets of this dish.

At the same time the guests, separated in groups, will venture to prepare their own ceviche and taste their own seasoning.

4. Swimming with sea lions (Private service)

During the whole tour, we will observe open sea, rocky Islands, dung birds, fishermen boats at work and a Humboldt penguin rookery. Arriving to the far point on route, the Palomino Island, a huge sea lion rookery appears, a group come to us playing, swimming, jumping and diving below the boat. Wearing wetsuits, we might jump into the water with life vests and share the ocean with them, swimming with them; sometimes the young ones come up and touch us out of curiosity; the old ones keep a 5 meters' distance from us.

They live in comfort because there are no predators. Being in the water close to the colony is an amazing moment for everyone who likes nature and wildlife. Heading back, the boat passes amazing rookeries with many bird colonies.

Once in calm waters we have a snack talking about the experience.

5. Green Lima from above (Private service)

Watch Lima city and it's beautiful beaches, all in a quick helicopter flight.

Operation season: Only during Peru summer season. From Monday to Sunday during day light hours.

Route: Airport - San Isidro district - Green coast - Larcomar - Planetary - Christ of the Pacific - Airport.

6. Paragliding (Private service)

Guided by a specially trained instructor, on a paraglider for two people enjoy a very quiet, relaxing and simple flight over the beaches, Miraflores buildings and most visited places like Parque del Amor and Larcomar.

7. Surf and bike tour (Private service)

Perfect opportunity to surf on the Pacific coast guided from surf instructor, who can adapt the lessons as well as to beginners or advanced surfers. Waves are not too big or too small, making it possible an enjoyable surf session for everybody!

By allowing you to have a bicycle for a full day it is also perfect to enjoy the streets of Lima by your own and its beautiful views, parks, streets, Bayview, and coast!

8. Bohemian bike tour (Private service)

Full of amazing views and great places where to stop, relax and chill to take some time to appreciate one of the most beautiful and bohemian districts of Lima.

During this tour, you will enjoy one of the first 20 best boardwalk in the world, while we are heading to the bohemian part of the city, Barranco, here we can enjoy a nice trip through the old train lines, see the old wood bridge “Bridge of sights”, then we continue to enjoy one of the best dishes in the world “ceviche” complete fresh, in a see view restaurant, and on our way there we can probably see an old monk jumping right from the cliff, remembering an old love history (1860), between Clarita Marques’s daughter, and Francisco, housekeeping ‘son, he jumps from the cliff went her father was taking here away to another different country then she jumps too from the boat, both die.

9. The Storyteller Bike Tour (Private service)

Our tour begins with the wonderful view of the Miraflores boardwalk to continue with the artistic part where we will visit the iconic MATE Museum, home of a permanent exhibition of photographs of the famous Peruvian photographer Mario Testino, complementing with the cultural we continue the tour with the guided visit to the Pedro de Osma Museum, located in a beautiful mansion of the 20th century of beautiful and dazzling architecture. Includes tasting of Peruvian coffee at Bisetti and tasting of Causa at Javier restaurant.

10. Lima modern (Private service)

This ride tour begins through the district of San Isidro, we are going to pass through Lima Golf Club, Huaca Huallamarca, El Olivar park to continue for the main streets of Miraflores a district with beautiful parks and a magnificent view of the Pacific Ocean. Continue the ride to Barranco a bohemian district with Republican houses.



11. Larco Museum + light cocktail at Museo Larco Cafe (Private service)

Housed in an 18th century viceroyalty-era mansion, surrounded by beautiful gardens, the [Larco Museum](#) is a stimulating and inspiring space in which visitors can enjoy and learn more about the fascinating history of ancient Peru. This museum is considered one of the best 25 museums in the world. Finish the visit enjoying light cocktail at the gardens of the restaurant. *Cocktail includes 04 appetizers, 01 drink. Duration 15 to 20 minutes.



12. City tour + lunch (Private service)

We will start our private visit in historical downtown Lima beginning with the Plaza de Armas (Lima's main square). Surrounded by colonial mansions, the Government Palace, Plaza de Armas (Lima's main square) surrounded by colonial mansions, the Cathedral and Lima's City Government building. The tour continues at the San Francisco Church, Convent and world-famous catacombs. It ends with a visit to the traditional but modern districts of San Isidro and Miraflores.



13. Magic fountains of water at night (Private service)

We begin our tour with a visit to the Magic Water Circuit at Parque de la Reserva. This recently remodeled park boasts 12 beautiful water fountains that literally "dance" to the music with special lighting and laser beams. This park is the pride of Lima and has been recognized by the Guinness Book of World Records as the largest water fountain park in the world. You will also see the 80-meter high largest water fountain in the world.
