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1. Scenic Views of Mykonos

duration 4 hrs

Mykonos Island is world-famous for its unique landscape, windmills, beautiful bays, superb beaches, white houses and churches with their red or blue domes.

First we will pass by Ornos Beach, one of the most stunning and cosmopolitan beaches with plenty of luxurious hotels, tavernas and yachts mooring offshore.

We will continue by passing by Agios Ioannis beach for photo shooting, the Paradise beach and San Stefanos located on the north end.

As you head to the center of the island to visit the village of Ano Mera, you will have a short photo stop at the beach of Kalafatis.

After a short visit to the Monastery Panayia Tourliani you will enjoy Ouzo and Greek appetizers at the peaceful little square of the village.

You will then arrive in Mykonos town where you will have a 1 ½ hours walking tour visiting the Windmills and Kastro area where the famous church of Paraportiani and Little Venice are located.



2. Magnificent Delos

duration 4 hrs

Not far from Mykonos lays the island of Delos, the 'island of light'.

According to mythology, Zeus, the king of the gods, fell in love with a beautiful Titaness named Leto, but when his wife discovered his infidelity, she forbade Mother Earth to give Leto refuge. Lonely and pregnant, Leto wandered the earth until the island appeared amid the waves so that she would have a place to give birth to twins: Artemis, goddess of the hunt and virginity, and Apollo, god of truth and light. Pilgrims from all over Greece came to pay their respects, creating one of the wealthiest and most revered shrines of antiquity.

After reaching the island by chartered boat, you'll discover among the ruins, one of the island's most spectacular relics, the Avenue of the Lions, where perfect replicas of the 7th century Naxian marble beasts crouch in silent vigilance at the Sacred Lake where Leto gave birth to her twins. Beyond, a path leads to Mt. Kynthos, where Zeus observed the event.

It is 368 feet to the summit, and for the fit ones it is worth every step.

There are many other interesting monuments which you'll be able to admire during your visit.

Note: Delos is explored on foot and the two-hour walk is over uneven terrain. We recommend sun protection.



3. Private Jeep Tour

duration 5 - 6 hrs

Experience the “wild” rural side of Mykonos on this 150 Km off-road epic excursion on Mykonian back roads . See the hidden corners of the island of Mykonos many of them inaccessible unless by jeep

Driving through the rugged terrain, Enjoy breathtaking views, rural areas, isolated beaches, lighthouses and the old deserted mining town and the unique feeling of driving in a jeep.

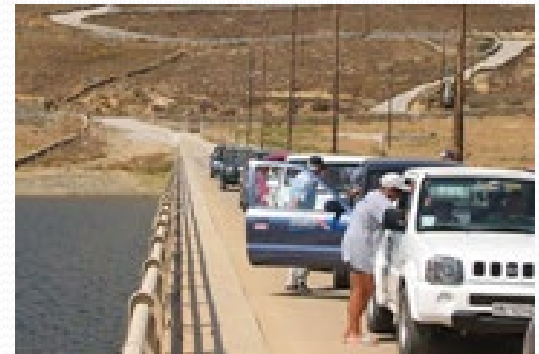
Our tour takes us first **along the coast** to Choulakia beach and from there up to the **light house**. From there we drive through the area of Marathi past **the dam** and Panormos beach to the **bay of Agios Sostis**. Then we drive to the area of Ano Mera where we have a stop at Paleokastro, **the ruins of a Venetian Castle**. We explore the area around Ano Mera with its **agriculture** and the nearby **old abandoned mine**.

Lunch stop in a picturesque place or beach (optional)

Then we continue along the **south coast** and drive past Kalafatis and Kalo Livadi through the green area of **Halara**. Our next stop is at one of the island famous beaches where we have time for a **swim and relax**. From there we head back for Mykonos town having as the last high light of the tour a photo stop at the old castle above the city.

REMARKS & REQUIREMENTS:

- Driver should be over 22 years old
- Valid driver's license valid
- Credit card as guarantee
- Don't forget to take beach equipment, sun protection, water and good shoes



4. Full Day Mykonos Tour

duration 7 hrs

Arguably the best known of all the Greek islands, Mykonos is renowned today for its nightlife and lively beaches. Following the Greek War of Independence, during which Mykonos played a significant role, life settled down for awhile before it was 'rediscovered' as a beautiful location for filming, attracting actors, artists and jet setters. Today, both the lifestyle and true history of the island are showcased through this **walking tour** of unique Mykonos town.

First you will visit the Mykonos Archaeological Museum, which houses pottery from Delos and jewelry from the Island of Renia, the Delos necropolis. Among the museum's highlights is an exhibit of a pithos, or Minoan storage jug, which features a Trojan War scene in relief, and a statue of Hercules.

Continue your walk with an exploration of the Mykonos that tourists seldom see, and discover her mysteries amid narrow winding streets lined with whitewashed houses and walled gardens.

We will continue with visiting Castro area where the Little Venice and Paraportiani church are located.

Now they stand as symbols of the island and afford a wonderful photo opportunity.

Our tour will now continue by car by passing by some of the nicest beaches of the island like Aghios Ioannis, Paradise and Kalafatis to admire the beauty and to take some pictures.

Tour will stop at Ano Mera traditional village for lunch and visit of Panagia Tourliani and will return to Mykonos town.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Tour is dependent on weather conditions and entails 1½ - 2 hours of walking on cobblestone streets with slight inclines and a few steps.



5. Delos & Rhenia islands Full day tour

Approx. duration: 7 hours

Follow the path of the Gods!

The small island of the Aegean, nowadays uninhabited, is one of the most important archaeological sites of the antiquity in the eastern Mediterranean sea. The island lies at the heart of the Cyclades - the archipelago takes its name from the fact that it encircles sacred Delos ("kyklos" is the Greek word for circle) Delos is the legendary birthplace of the twin gods Apollo and Artemis. Remains of Temples and residences dating back from the Neolithic to the Roman periods.

A trip that includes the services of a professional guide to the sacred Island of Apollo and Artemis, famous politically and religiously in antiquity.

Visit includes the Sanctuary of Apollo with its three temples dating from the 6th and 5th centuries BC, the amphitheatre, built in 300 BC to accommodate 5,500 spectators and the spectacular museum of Delos.

*Please note that this tour always subjects to weather conditions .



Add to your experience of exploring the ancient Delos a swim in the emerald blue waters of Rhenia. After our passage from the sacred island , we will continue our sail out getting to a beautiful isolated beach of Rhenia. You will have the opportunity to swim at the crystal clear waters and taste original greek food. Water or soft drinks as well as excellent local drinks will be available during our sail and by the time we arrive the island a BBQ with the most fresh fish or meat will take place. You'll be invited to try a variety of greek appetizers and local wine. Enjoy 4 incredible hours under the dazzling sun and indulge in the clearest turquoise waters in the world. Finishing lunch and swimming , will start our departure for Mykonos.
