### EXTENSION OF THE ROUTE

#### DAY 6 (SAT) PETEN – TIKAL – PETEN

Breakfast. Today we will visit the Mayan city of Tikal, the jewel of the classic Mayan world. We will enjoy a country lunch inside the archeological enclosure. Return to the hotel. Lodging.

#### DAY 7 (SUN) PETEN – YAXHA – PETEN

Breakfast. In the morning we will visit the spectacular Mayan city of Yaxha, with its sacred lagoon. Lunch at a local restaurant. Return to the hotel. Lodging.

#### DAY 8 (MON) PETEN – GUATEMALA – LA ANTIGUA

Breakfast. In the morning we take our transfer to the airport of Flores to take a flight destined for Guatemala. Reception and transfer to the city of La Antigua. For the orientation visit of this colonial city, declared Patrimony of Humanity, we will pass through the Cathedral, the Central Plaza, the principal monuments and museums. Lodging.

#### DAY 9 (TUE) LA ANTIGUA

Breakfast. We will have the day free to enjoy La Antigua, walking along its cobblestone streets, appreciating the architectural styles of old or relaxing at the hotel's facilities. As an optional activity, during the morning we recommend paying a cultural visit to the city or to the Coffee Plantation. Lodging.

#### DAY 10 (WED) LA ANTIGUA – IXIMCHE – ATITLAN

Breakfast. Departure toward the interior of the Guatemalan Highlands. On the way, we will visit the archeological site of Iximche, ancient Mayan capital of the Cakchiquel kingdom. Following the visit we will continue onwards toward Lake Atitlan, of which Huxley spoke of as the most beautiful in the world. Lodging.

#### DAY 11 (THUR) ATITLAN – CHICHICASTENANGO – ATITLAN

Breakfast. Early in the morning we will transfer to the village of Chichicastenango, where we will enjoy an excursion along the most famous indigenous markets of Latin America. On this day we will have a hands-on experience, where we will work alongside local women of the community in a corn workshop, the basic staple of Guatemala. Lodging.

#### DAY 12 (FRI) ATITLAN – SANTIAGO – SAN ANDRÉS XECUL – QUETZALTENANGO

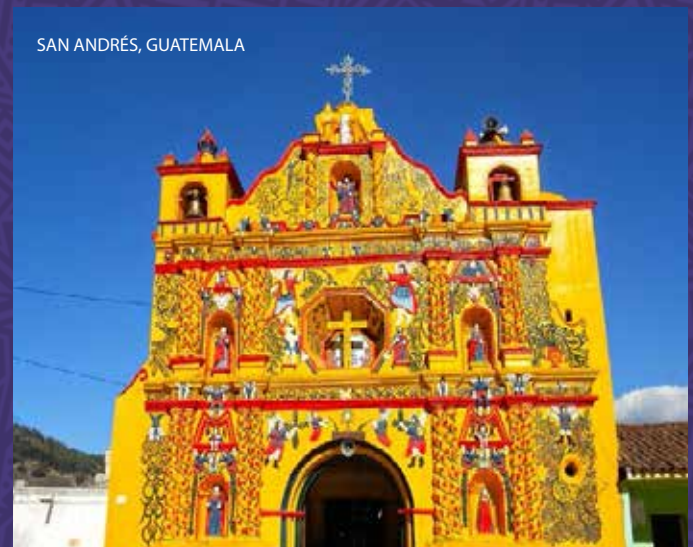
Breakfast. In the morning we will take a boat to visit the village of Tzutuuhil of Santiago. Following the excursion we will continue onwards to Quetzaltenango, to visit this colonial city that still conserves its ancient traditions of the Maya-Quiché lineage, conjugated with a colonial past and a dynamic modern life. On the road, we will visit San Andrés Xecul, possessor of an imposing parrochial temple with a spectacular façade. Lodging.

#### DAY 13 (SAT) QUETZALTENANGO – ALMOLONGA – ZUNIL – SALCAJA – GUATEMALA CITY

Breakfast. Today we will visit the market of Almolonga, renowned for its generous crops. We will continue onwards toward Zunil, one of the pre-columbine populations, famous for its regional weaves and cloths. We will visit Salcajá, the first producer of marbled cloth, applied by the women in their forms of dress. We will also get to know the Hermitage Church or The Conqueror, which was the first catholic church of Guatemala. Following the excursions, return to Guatemala City. Lodging.

#### DAY 14 (SUN) GUATEMALA – AIRPORT OF GUATEMALA

Breakfast. At the convened hour, we will transfer you to the airport of Guatemala City and the conclusion of our services.
