

THE FRESH AIR OF NORDIC NATURE.

Day 1: Tunis - Testour - Tabarka.

After breakfast, pick-up in front of the hotel in Tunis. Visit the city of Testour, including the clock tower (unique in the world) and the Ibrahim Riahi Cultural Center (Chalet la famous Hbibba Msika). Visit the ben Ismail Beja estate for lunch and tasting of local products. Head to Beni Mtir for a visit to the charming village and a hike in the mountainous forest and along the banks of the great Beni Mtir Dam. Check-in at Benir Metir Outdoors, free time, dinner at the camping center.

Day 2: Tabarka - Ain Drahem - Beni Mtir.

Breakfast at the camping center, head to Ain Drahem for an unusual visit in Tunisia with its houses with red roofs staggered on the hillside. Bucolic landscapes and charming lakes await you on the mountain roads. Free time in Ain Drahem to discover artisanal products made from cork, heather, tree bark, olive wood, and rattan. Lunch at a restaurant in Ain Drahem and continue on to Tabarka. Check-in at the Dar El Karma guesthouse. Free activities (health trail, fishing on the Oued El Kébir, walks between river and sea with pedal boats and kayaks, cycling on a track of over 25 km). Dinner at Dar El Karma guesthouse, group evening entertainment.

Day 3: Tabarka - Ain Drahem - Beni Mtir - Tunis.

Breakfast at the guesthouse, visit Tabarka. Free time to visit the needles and marina, where fishing boats mingle with pleasure boats. Nearby are the jewelers who offer wonders in coral beads, the pride of the city. Artisans also make beautiful objects from cork, harvested in the region, and carved wood. Lunch at the Pure Nature Tabarka restaurant, return to the guesthouse, and quad biking in the forest.

Day 4: Tabarka - Ain Drahem - Beni Mtir - Tunis.

Breakfast at the guesthouse, head to Beja for a visit to the city (purchase of local pastries, locally-produced cheeses, etc.).

Head to Dar Baya for lunch and then return to Tunis.
