A LA CARTE TOUR OPTIONS

1. Champagne bites (Private service)

A two-hour trip will take you and your partner or friends on an easy cruise in a yacht around the Paracas Bay. Enjoy Peruvian delicacies and sparkling wine while magnificent scenery unfolds before your eyes with every mile navigated. * Subject to weather conditions.

Includes: Wine, beer, soft drinks, light dishes based on seafood.

2. E-bikes (Private service)

The E-bikes are the perfect tool to visit the Paracas National Reserve. They do not pollute; they do not make noise and they are a versatile and fun vehicle. This experience seeks to offer all the advantages described without making much effort, since the bicycle engine assists our pedaling all the time.

Approximate activity time: 2 hours. Flexible time of departure. Approximate distance: 27 Km.

3. Sea Kayaks (Private service)

According to naturalists and birdwatchers, kayaks are the best way to cruise the bay. This agile boat fit one or two people.

No noise, no pollution and they bring an incredible sense of achievement once we see everything Paracas has to offer without scaring away fauna.

Departure from the Hotel Paracas lobby to Punta Pejerrey, a former scallop camp within the Paracas National Reserve. Cruise to the Atenas beach, where we can see cormorants, pelicans and gulls. We then row into

Punta Ballenas against the wind, in these shallow waters we'll be able to spot different kinds of seashells and, if we're lucky, flamingoes. With the wind on our backs, we return to Punta Pejerrey.

3. Nasca Lines from Ica + Lunch at Hacienda Caravedo

At schedule time private transfer to Ica with assistance for overflight Nasca lines. Our ancient Nascas have left us an invaluable legacy: an archeological monument consisting of a network of lines forming designs of animals and plants. It is located between kilometer 419 and kilometer 465 of the South Pan American Highway, covering an area of approximately 350 square kilometers. They were discovered by Toribio Mejía Xesspe.

They have been studied by Paul Kosok, Hans Horkheimer and the German doctor María Reiche. She lived in the area for 50 years, investigating their origin.

Flights are from 10:00 to 16:30hrs. * Subject to weather conditions

5. Romantic dinner in the dessert (Private service)

Combine adrenaline rushes with the majestic beauty of the Ica desert on this exciting buggy and sandboarding tour.

Take an unconventional route through the desert, racing across the hot sand on a dune buggy or on sandboard, or enjoy a unique experience through one of the driest deserts in the world in 4x4s prepared especially for this type of cruises and conducted by experts from the spectacular dunes of Paracas, ending with a romantic picnic or dinner in the middle of the desert.



6. Ballestas Islands (Shared service)

We begin this tour picking you up at the hotel and taking you to the Paracas Pier located at Paracas Bay where we will board the boat that will take us to the Ballestas Islands. During our trip you will see huge colonies of guano birds, like boobies, tendrils, guanays, Humboldt penguins and sea lions. On the route, to the northwest side of the bay you will also see a famous geoglyph known as “The Candelabra”, “The Trident” or “The Three Crosses”. It is 120 meters long and 78 meters wide. Some people associate its origins with the Nasca Lines.
