### Sample: Slovenian Weekend (3-day package)

Itinerary For Roundabout's client

- Day 1 ARRIVAL, Ljubljana - the vibrant capital
- Day 2 Skocjan Caves, Piran & Predjama Castle
- Day 3 Bled & Bohinj Lakes with Skofja Loka, DEPARTURE



Private transfer\* from Ljubljana airport and arrival to Ljubljana the beloved (\*pickup time is flexible and adjustable to flight schedule).

It will make you fall in love with it at first glance. It captures you with its warm-hearted character, lively cosmopolitan vibe and warm and welcoming people. Ljubljana has it all big European capital city vibe yet intimate and genuine touch.

The old city centre offers one-of-a-kind architectural appearance, particularly due to the unique combination of Baroque and Art Nouveau architecture and masterful creations by the 20th century architect Joe Plenik.

Our guide will pick you up in front of your hotel and take you on a sightseeing tour. You will get to know why Triple Bridge is actually triple, where locals buy their food, how Napoleon was one of the most popular politicians, why Slovenia really lives with LOVE in our name also in Ljubljana and... well, we don't want to tell you too much. What is certain, this will be the first visit to Ljubljana out of many more that will follow.

- Option 1: Top Ljubljana Foods tour

Take a walk on the tasty side of Ljubljana and wander the streets and squares with stops to grab delicious bites. Learn about story of Ljubljana, the people, its architecture, the history of Slovenians while enjoying local dishes.

The Top Ljubljana Foods tour will take you through the old Ljubljana town. During a 3-4 hour guided, slowly paced walk you will learn about the city and its most significant attractions while tasting local and national gastronomy. Top Ljubljana Foods is definitely not your usual city tour.

9 traditional dishes from various Slovenian regions accompanied by 4 sorts of wine, while learning about the historical Ljubljana center and Slovenia in general. With your tummy full and armed with knowledge of local traditions, cuisine and history, you will definitely know where to go next and where to eat next. “Dober tek!”

- Option 2: Ljubljana bike cruise (seasonal activity!)

What a great way to explore Ljubljana on wheels! Not only the main attractions, located in the pedestrian zone, but an unique opportunity to cover a wider area without skipping the cozy stops where locals enjoy soaking up the city vibe.

Hop on a comfortable fat-tire stylish beach cruiser bicycle and enjoy Ljubljana from a different perspective. The group meets in front of the Tourist Information Center by the Triple Bridge where bikes are provided. The main advantage of exploring the lively capital on two wheels is the ability to see interesting places outside of the pedestrian city center, such as the beautiful Ljubljanica River embankments, abandoned military objects and beautifully arranged lush green park areas.

Cycling is easy and smooth on Ljubljana flat terrains. Cruise through the city’s hidden narrow streets, stop to see the major attractions, explore the Roman remains and architectural wonders scattered all over the city. Visit some of the most interesting districts of Ljubljana and have fun discovering different vibes as you wander the paths that only locals know about. For the cherry on top? We take you for a drink in the center to soak up Ljubljana’s vibrant atmosphere!

UNESCO karst attraction the Skocjan Caves, the oldest and most notorious stud farm, known all over the world, and the picturesque coastal towns all wrapped up in one single fantastic tour.

Discover the Slovenian coast and the Karst region. The first stop are the UNESCO listed Skocjan Caves, one of the largest and most fascinating karstic sites in Europe with the Reka River running 200 m below the surface.

Next stop is at one of the local taverns for the famous Karst air-dried prosciutto tasting; we like to think it is one of the best prosciuttos in the world, accompanied with the local wine Teran produced only in this region. Head on to for a short stop at Lipica, the homeland of the white Lipizzaner famous horse of the Spanish riding school in Vienna.

Pass the coastal towns of Koper, Izola and Portoroz and reach everyone's favourite spot on the Slovenian coast Piran. Get lost in its medieval narrow streets and houses, enjoy some free time over an exquisite seafood meal in one of the many local restaurants or cafes.

One last photostop at Predjama Castle on the way to Ljubljana. Discover the secrets of the largest cave castle (Guinness World Records!), located on a 123-meter high cliff, and learn about the local Robin Hood legendary knight Erazem.

**Optional supplements:**

- Prosciutto & wine tasting: from 7 € / person

- Skocjan Caves: from 16 € - 20 € / person (depends on the season)
- Piran walls: 2 € / person

Bled & Bohinj Lakes with Skofja Loka, DEPARTURE



Only a short drive from Ljubljana, discover Slovenia's most spectacular natural sites the famous Alpine jewels of Bled, Bohinj and Vintgar Gorge together with the medieval town of Skofja Loka.

From Ljubljana to the Alpine region below the Julian Alps we reach Bled, the magnificent Alpine resort. Ascend the old castle perched on top of a steep cliff above the glacial Lake Bled. The castle terraces offer spectacular views of the lake and its tiny island in the middle. Take a boat ride with 'Pletna' traditional boat made by locals and reach the only true island in Slovenia. Continue to the impressive Vintgar Gorge, one of the most stunning natural canyons, where a wooden path takes you along the rushing Radovna River, through the picturesque gorge and ends with the 26-metre-high waterfall Sum.

Our next stop is Bohinj, Slovenia's largest glacial lake, located in the Triglav National Park area. Take a swim or a canoe ride or just a pleasant walk around the lake area. Bohinj's natural environment will impress you with its different faces in each season of the year.

On the way back we can stop in Skofja Loka, one of the oldest and best-preserved Slovenian towns. Stop for a walk around the charming town center, situated under the castle and the monastery.

Ljubljana airport drop off case of an evening flight or additional night in Ljubljana (on request) and private transfer to the airport on the next day and end of your Slovenia adventure. This time it was just for 3 days, but you will definitely want to return :)

***Optional supplements:***

- Vintgar Gorge: 10 € / person (Summer season only - April to October)
- Pletna boat ride: 15 € / person
- Bled Castle: 13 € / person
