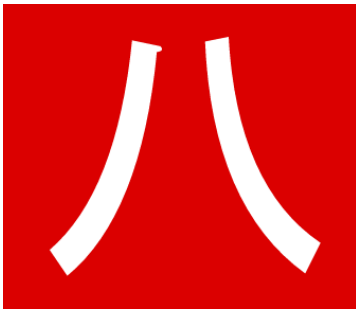

Day 1

Arrival to Barcelona Airport - Private transfer to Hotel

Day 2

FD tour Barcelona

Head out on a full day tour of Barcelona. Pretty much everyone who visits Barcelona falls in love with it. For many, it is their dream destination. This enchanting city has everything: it is a cosmopolitan European city that preserves its traditional shops and street markets, has a mountain, beaches and it has historical and artistic icons. The facades of its residential buildings are colourful and unique, full of details from the artistic movements, Modernism. The Parc Guell, a masterpiece of Gaudi, affords one of the best known views over the city . The Placa de Catalunya is the city's central point. Behind it stretches the Eixample, the largest residential neighbourhood and it is here that many of Gaudi's buildings are located. Downhill to the north is the Ciutat Vella, the Old City enclosed by the walls. It is flanked by La Barceloneta, one of Europe's most appealing beaches. The old centre takes in the multicultural El Raval, the Barri Gotic (Gothic neighbourhood), bordered by La Rambla and El Born, the city's most elegant neighbourhood and home to the Museu Picasso .

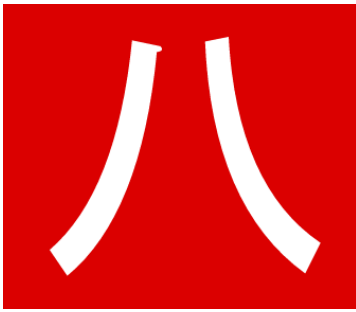

Parasailing and snorkeling

Take to the skies of Ibiza with this parasailing experience in San Antonio and enjoy excellent views of the western coast of the Pitiusa island - pure adrenaline!

After receiving prior directions from the instructor, we'll head to the port of San Antonio to set sail aboard a speedboat. The speed of the boat will allow those who are attached to the harnesses at that moment to rise up to 400 metres thanks to the impulse of a parachute.

During the parasailing experience, which will be 15 minutes per person, you'll be able to observe the landscapes of San Antonio Bay. From there, you'll also have a bird's eye view of the islets, mountains, beaches and cliffs of this beautiful corner of the Mediterranean.

If you're feeling adventurous you can finish the parasailing experience by taking a dip in the sea directly from the parachute - a real adrenaline rush! This Balearic island is even more beautiful from above, so you can take advantage of your parasailing flight to see its breathtaking coastline.

After that, we will relax in a boat trip

We'll arrive at Tagomago, the beautiful white sand island with restricted access, and have time to take a dip and snorkel. Marvel at the marine depths!

Then we'll go to Cala Martina, one of the most idyllic corners of the island and spend an hour discovering the unknown paradise.

The tour will continue to Playa de Bossa. There we'll change the boat for a jet ski and, ride along the coast. The next destination will be the paradisiacal island of Espalmador. The turquoise waters and the snorkeling equipment will be all you need to discover the marine depths.

Back on the boat, we'll sail past the Es Vedrá rock. As the sun starts to set, we'll head to a local restaurant to enjoy a delicious menu of paella and salad.

Day 5

FD tour Eivissa

Only 15 Spanish cities have been declared World Heritage Sites, and one of them is the capital of Ibiza. From the port of this beautiful Balearic city we'll set off on a private tour through the most emblematic streets of its old town.

The walled enclosure of Dalt Vila, in the heart of the historic centre, will be the first stop on this private tour of Ibiza Town. Its walls are a living vestige of the different Mediterranean communities who fought in this area of the Balearic Islands. Its strategic location made it the subject of disputes over the centuries which we'll find out about on the tour.

As well as its fort, the Ibizan capital is also known for its picturesque streets of whitewashed buildings. Many of these beautiful white buildings experienced a boom in the 60s due to the famous hippie movement that we'll talk about during the tour.

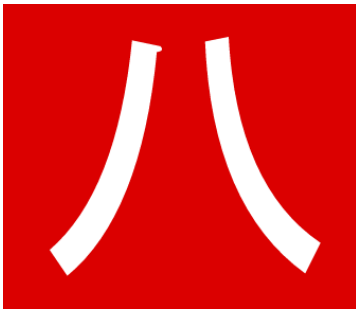
On this tour, we'll take you to one of the most famous hippie markets in Ibiza, where you can find all kinds of souvenirs and gifts. Depending on the day we'll either go to Es Canar or Las Dalias. On Wednesdays, the tour visits the Es Canar market, and on Saturdays we enjoy the Las Dalias market - both taking place in the Santa Eulalia area.
