OVERVIEW PROGRAM

Day 1. DOUALA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Arrival and reception at Douala international airport from Europe, transfer and installation at the Hotel. Dinner and night at the Hotel

Day 2: DOUALA-LIMBE-MBOUROUKOU (Villa KLEBER)

Early wake-up, breakfast. Early departure from Douala for Limbé, for the visit. Arrival and visit Melong, stop in Penja to visit the Penja pepper plantation and continuation to Melong. Arrival and accommodation at Villa Kleber, where you will visit the small crater, the coffee plantation, the coffee processing factory and the cheese factory. Dinner and night.

Day 3: Villa Kléber-Mont MANENGOUMBA-Villa KLEBER

Wake up very early around 7:30 a.m. and leave after breakfast for the trek & hike to Mount Manengouba, and the visit of the Twin Lakes and the villages of Bororo nomadic shepherds. It will take you about 6 hours



to get there and back. Return to Villa Kleber for a rest and a dip in the swimming pool.

Day 4: VILLA KLEBER DSCHANG-BAFOUSSAM-FOUMBAN

Departure in the morning after breakfast for the Ekom-Nkam waterfalls, where part of the film TARZAN by Christophe Lambert was filmed, and continuation to Foumban via Bafoussam. Arrival at Foumban; check-in at the PEKASSA hotel and visit the Palace and Museum of the Sultanate of Foumban: seat of the Bamoun Sultanate, artisanal capital of the west, guardian of two museums and a palace, Foumban is one of the main tourist sites in the country . Let your children guide you through the city whose history dates back to the 17th century to the Sultan's Palace, a unique and strange building. The Sultan's Museum houses thrones, trophies, weapons and statues that belonged to the ancestors of the current Sultan. The Bamoun Museum of Arts and Traditions, one of the most beautiful museums in the country, contains a rich collection of art objects. Stroll along the rue des artisans, where wood carvers, founders and blacksmiths work before your eyes. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 5. FOUMBAN-BAFOUSSAM--BANDJOUN-BATOUFAM-VILLA BOUTANGA

Wake up early and have breakfast and return to Bafoussam (Welcome to Bamiléké country, a densely populated region where society is organized into a multitude of chiefdoms, ancient religious and political kingdoms whose original architecture and spectacular dances with masks and multicolored beads have given the whole country the best-known image of its tradition. Once you arrive in Bafang, you enter the Bamiléké country, a vast green plateau cut with valleys. The Bandjoun chiefdom is the most beautiful and best preserved. 20 km from Bafoussam, this traditional town is lost in a cirque of greenery, with its bamboo and thatch huts built according to the traditional model, the chiefdom of Batoufam and its museum could one day become as famous as that of Bandjoun. After visiting the Batouffam chieftaincy museum, continue to Villa Boutanga. Dinner and night at Villa Boutanga. Dinner and night.

Day 6. Villa BOUTANGA-BANGANTE-YAOUNDE



Wake up early, breakfast. Visit the Jean GATCHA Foundation. Departure for Yaoundé, observation of the landscape, the villages and meeting with the different populations throughout the route. Arrival in Yaoundé. Installation at the hotel. Dinner in a restaurant to discover Cameroonian gastronomy. Return to the hotel and overnight.

Day 7. YAOUNDE-SOMALOMO

Morning wake up. Early departure for the Dja biodiversity reserve. Lunch en route to the Dja. Arrival in Somalomo and continuation to the pygmy camp in the Dja biodiversity reserve, accompanied by porters and an eco guard. Arrival and installation at the pygmy camp. Presentation of gifts to the chief of the tribe. At nightfall ; organization of dances by the whole village around a large wood fire. Dinner and night in a tent at the Pygmy camp.

Day 8. PYGMY MAMA CAMP

Waking up early to the sounds of animals, birds, insects, etc. Breakfast. Start of activities among the pygmies; hunting, fishing and wild honey gathering activities, forest fruit picking, traditional water drawing, raffia wine harvesting, traditional fire lighting, pygmy hut construction, etc. introduction to traditional medicine. At nightfall; organization of dances by the whole village around a large wood fire. Dinner and night in a tent at the Pygmy camp.

Day 9: PYGMEE-SOMALOMO-YAOUNDE CAMP - EBOGO

Morning wake up ; breakfast. Return to Yaoundé. Arrival in Yaoundé and continuation to the Eco tourist site of the Ebogo forest reserve, after Mbalmayo. Arrival and installation at the hotel. Dinner and night.

Day 10: EBOGO FOREST RESERVE-MEFOU-YAOUNDÉ PARK

The fabulous EBOGO tourist site on the banks of the Nyong River: the majestic and tranquil Mbalmayo forest reserve, in the company of the Ebogo canoeists. Tens of thousands of species of birds and butterflies to observe. Remarkable sites like the 300-year-old Sappeli tree (12 m in circumference and 1200 years old). The canoeists will tell you about nature, culture and the work of man in magnificent landscapes. They will show you the secrets of the rainforest and the river. Then return to the banks of the Nyong River for breakfast with fresh fish. Hiking and trekking on the trail. Return to Yaoundé. Stop at Mefou National Park,



where you can observe large primates - gorillas, chimpanzees and monkeys. Continuation to Yaoundé. Arrival and installation at the hotel. Dinner and night.

Day. 11. YAOUNDE-EDEA-KRIBI

Early wake-up, breakfast. Departure for Kribi via Edéa. Arrival in Kribi: The arrival in Kribi is striking; the ocean appears with its white sand beaches stretching as far as the eye can see, lined with rows of coconut trees. The coast of Kribi is the true Cameroonian riviera, a world in contact with the equatorial forest and the ocean. Londji, the most beautiful beach in Cameroon, offers a dream vacation spot. The Lobé Falls flow directly into the ocean in a series of waterfalls, a unique phenomenon in the world. In a magical setting, this river tumbles down a thirty meter high cliff, widening the sky with its spray. You can discover a little further, two typical fishing villages, Eboundja and Ebodjé, where the fishing is almost miraculous. Arrival and installation at the hotel. Free evening. Dinner and night.

Day.12. KRIBI

Breakfast and departure to go canoeing on the Lobe River towards a small Pygmy Camp. Afterwards, return to the Lobe waterfall, the only one which falls directly into the ocean in the world, possible tasting of seafood on site and return to the hotel, free evening.

Day.13. KRIBI-DOUALA-EUROPE

Free morning and in the afternoon, drive to Douala, visit the flower and craft market and other shopping in local boutiques then continue to the airport for boarding formalities and flight. End of stay
