DAY 1: Khugnu Tarna natural reserve

Start your day by heading up to Khugnu Tarna natural reserve (Also called as a Semi Gobi), an expansive sand dune stretching over 80km. Main attractions include Khugnu Khan sacred mountain, Elsen Tasarkhai Sand Dunes and Shireet Tsagaan Lake. The area is surrounded by sand dunes, hills covered with rare bushes and a small forest near a river. Together this presents a unique combination of Mongolian mountains, forests and Gobi desert -type landscape in one location. Enhance your Mongolian experience with Camel riding - atop the two-humped Bactrian camel on a sand dune.

Main activity : Camel riding, Sightseeing.





DAY 2-6 Horse riding through Orkhon Valley

Days dedicated to the unparalleled joy of horse riding in Unesco world heritage site- Orkhon Valley. It is one of the most visited tourist attractions in Central Mongolia. It is formed by the unique combination of volcanic eruption and earthquake. On Day 2 we will reach Orkhon Valley. Starting from day 3 we will start our horse riding for 4 days. In the valley, we ride to the naiman nuur lake, serene place only touched by human and horse feet. Average horse riding time 4-6 hours per day.

Main activity : Meeting Nomads, Sightseeing, Horse riding, visiting lakes and waterfall, playing traditional games, campfire, Mongolian barbeque



DAY 7 : Tsenkher hot spring

We will drive to Tsenkher hot spring which offers relax in a cozy jacuzzi filled with natural, medicinal springs, surrounded by scenic mountains and forests. The 86°C hot spring water is famous for having curative properties for arthritic joints and other ailments. If walking in the forest, or hiking up to the mountain are other ways you may find more relaxing, you're free to do so.

Main activity : Wet Spa, Relaxing

DAY 8: Harhorin city

Harhorin, the former Mongolian Empire capital founded in 1220 in the Orkhon Valley, stood as the empire's heart for over 140 years until its 1391 destruction by Ming Dynasty troops.

After the lunch, we'll visit Mongolia's first Buddhist monastery, Erdene Zuu, established in 1586 on the ruins of the old capital. For better understanding about Mongolian history, we will visit the Harhorin's museum in the evening.

Main Activity : Erdenezuu monastery, Museum



DAY 9: Back to Ulaanbaatar

After a final breakfast in the nomadic setting, savor your time until you reach city. Upon arriving in Ulaanbaatar, have a farewell lunch at Mongolian restaurant accompanied by a traditional performance. Let the captivating displays of Mongolian traditional arts and music bring delightful close to your journey.

Main Activity : Traditional performance
