Conclude your day with a stroll through the vibrant night market, brimming with local crafts and culinary delights.

DAY 12

Luang Prabang - Trekking to Kuang Si Waterfall

Embark on a trekking adventure from Luang Prabang to Kuang Si Waterfall, passing through the picturesque village of Long Lao and learning about the Hmong and Khmu cultures along the way. Return to Luang Prabang in the afternoon.
