- Marvel at Seoul's contemporary side with visits to architectural gems like Dongdaemun Design Plaza and Seoul Tower, offering glimpses into South Korea's innovative spirit and modern skyline.

II. ITINERARY

DAY 1

Arrival in Seoul

Welcome to South Korea! Upon arrival at Incheon International Airport, a private chauffeur will be waiting to escort you to your hotel. The remainder of the day is yours to explore at your leisure.

DAY 2

Seoul City Tour & Flight to Jeju Island

After breakfast, meet your tour guide and driver at the hotel for a day of exploration in Seoul. Begin with a visit to Jogyesa Buddhist Temple, a vibrant center of Buddhist culture where you can observe locals in prayer. Continue to Gyeongbokgung Royal Palace to witness the majestic Guard Changing Ceremony, if available. Stroll through Insadong Art & Craft Street, visit the Kimchi Museum to delve into Korean food culture, and explore the historic Bukchon Hanok Village. Conclude your day with a visit to Cheonggyecheon and the City Planning Exhibition Hall before heading to the airport for your flight to Jeju Island, known as "Oriental Hawaii." Upon arrival, you'll be transferred to your hotel.

DAY 3

Jeju Island Exploration

Embark on a journey to Seongsan Sunrise Peak, the world's largest coastal crater, and Seopjikoji Cape for breathtaking views. Discover local life at Seongeup Folk Village and immerse yourself in the history of Jeju's female divers at Jeju Hanyeo Museum. Relax with a leisurely stroll along Woljeongri Beach.

DAY 4

Return to Seoul & Afternoon Sightseeing

Take a domestic flight back to Seoul in the morning and visit the renowned National Museum of Korea, home to extensive collections of archaeology, history, and art. Explore Namsan Hanok Village, where you may witness a traditional Korean wedding ceremony if it coincides with your visit. Ascend Seoul Tower via the Namsan Cable Car for panoramic views of the city, and marvel at the ultramodern architecture of Dongdaemun Design Plaza, often likened to a UFO.

DAY 5

Departure from Seoul

Your driver will pick you up from the hotel and transfer you to the airport for your departure flight. Wishing you a pleasant journey ahead!
