Cairo – Bahariya Oasis – White Desert – Dakhla Oasis –
Kharga Oasis – Luxor - Nile Cruise - Cairo
15 nights / 16 days

Day 1 - Cairo

Arrival at Cairo airport. Meet and assist by our representative, and you will be transferred to your hotel overnight.

Day 2 - Cairo

Have your breakfast at the hotel. Your private Egyptologist tour guide and driver will pick you up to start your day tour.

Drive to Sakkara to see the Step Pyramid, built by the exalted architect Imhotep for the 3rd Dynasty Pharaoh Djoser. You will visit one of the mastabas in Sakkara that dates to more than 4,500 years ago and see the amazing carvings and colors, which give an idea about life in ancient Egypt.

You will end your time in Sakkara in a carpet school, where you will be involved in an experience with locals who are being trained in the amazing handcraft of weaving, following in the footsteps of their ancestors, who started it thousands of years ago.

Have lunch at a restaurant.

Continue to Giza to visit one of the Ancient Seven Wonders of the World, the Great Pyramids. See the royal burial chamber of either Menkaure or Khafre Pyramids, the Valley Temple, and the Sphinx.

On your way, you will visit a papyrus institute where you will be taken on a journey through the craft using step-by-step demonstrations and extensive displays of papyrus artworks to view and have the chance to buy souvenirs. You can choose among hundreds of designs, including printing your name in hieroglyphics with scenes from ancient Egypt (the artworks are certified for using genuine papyrus).

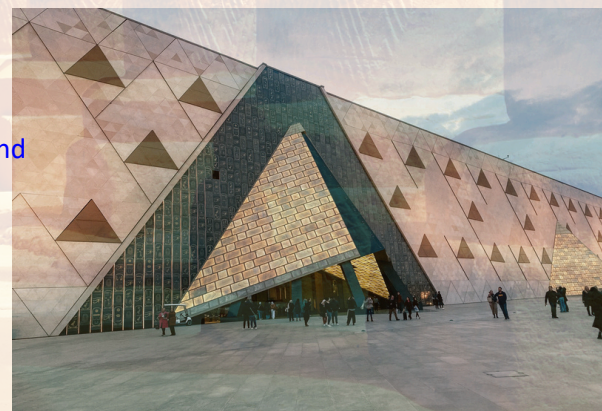
Return to your hotel overnight.

Day 3 - Cairo

Have your breakfast at the hotel. Your private Egyptologist tour guide and driver will pick you up to start your day tour.

Visit the Grand Egyptian Museum, which is filled with artifacts from thousands of years of Egyptian history, including the mummies of powerful pharaohs and treasures from the Tomb of Tutankhamun.

Have lunch at a restaurant. Return to your hotel.



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Day 4 - Cairo

Have your breakfast at the hotel. Your private Egyptologist tour guide and driver will pick you up to start your day tour.

Visit Moez Street, Qalawun Complex, Sabil Abdel Rahman Katkhuda, Suheimi House, and walk in the streets of Khan Al Khalili. Have lunch at Naguib Mahfouz restaurant, followed by coffee or tea in Al Fishawi coffee shop. Afterward, cross the street and visit Al Ghuria Complex. Visit the Nilometer and return to your hotel.

Day 5 – Cairo - Bahariya Oasis

Early morning, after breakfast, drive with your private guide in a Toyota Land Cruiser 2000 to Oasis Bahariya (About 4 and a half hours driving, 340 kilometers from Cairo). Bahariya is the nearest oasis to Cairo, surrounded by black hills made up of ferruginous quartzite and dolerite, and famous for its 398 mineral & sulfur springs, some of which have temperatures capital of the Oasis, occupying a hillside transfer to our hotel.

After lunch in a restaurant, you will start an afternoon tour amongst the top sights of Bahariya, including El Meftella Mountain, Salty Lake, Dest (Pyramid Mountain) & Maghrafa Mountain, stroll to Bir El Ghaba & El Matar warm springs with opportunity for bathing. Time permitting, a visit to the English Mountain will take place by sunset. Here, the old English outpost was used by British troops as it showed strategic views of the area. Have dinner at the hotel.

Day 6 - The Great Day to the White Desert

Early morning breakfast before journeying out into the Black Desert surrounding Bahariya Oasis, where the iron in the desert is one of the reasons for the black rocks. Accompanied by your private guide, you will walk to explore Gabal el Marsos (Divided Mountain) and then drive by 4X4 towards the small Bedouin village El Hez with an outdoor lunch break (picnic). Making your way to the White Desert 160 km on/off-road, you will stop by the Crystal Mountain to enjoy the small cave and the shiny stones, then drive to do the fantastic adventure by the valley of the Agabat el Sharkia, enjoy the view of sand dunes and play with sand boarding then move to one from the oldest tree in the desert it's El Santa tree, then go across the sands of the White Desert. The park is the site of large white chalk rock formations created through erosion by wind and sand. It is also the site of cliffs (at the northern end of the Farafra Depression), sand dunes (part of the Great Sand Sea), as well as Wadi Hennis and oases at Ain El Maqfi and Ain El Wadi.

The park serves as the refuge for various animals, including the endangered Rhim gazelle and the vulnerable dorcas gazelle, as well as Barbary sheep ; jackals ; ruppell's , red and fennec foxes; and the sand cat.

White Desert National Park covers an area of 3,010 km² (1,160 sq mi). The altitude in the park varies from 32 to 353 m (105 to 1,158 ft) above sea level. Tonight you will watch the sunset over the exquisite sands of the desert, dinner under the stars (picnic) and overnight camping in white desert.

Accommodation: camping in the desert (Big tents for dinner and small tents for sleeping, light inside the big tent, ice boxes during your tour, inside the small tent will be blankets, pillows, mattress, sleeping bags , and sheets, but there will be no beds)



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Day 7 - Full day Off Road tour in the White Desert area

After an incredible camping night with a special sunrise in the beautiful desert, accompanied by your private guide, you will drive to the Aqabat off Road area and stop by the Hole mountain, then continue driving to the Great karween sand dunes, enjoy the driving through the sand dunes and also we have availability for the sand boarding adventure there after the nice time by the dunes will be driving on the way to the Magic spring "Ain El serw" our delicious (picnic) lunch will be there beside the water spring in the middle of nowhere, after lunch will keep continuing driving on the way to white desert, in our way to the White Desert will stop by the big and small valleys and Henes Valley, also will stop by Acacia tree one from the oldest tree in the whole western desert then stop by tents Valley for takes incredible photos, then drive to the Dakhla oasis arrived there late afternoon drive directly to the hotel. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 8 - Dakhla Oasis

After breakfast, enjoy our full day tour in Dakhla Oasis with your private guide. In this huge green farming oasis, we will visit: The old Islamic town of Qasr Dakhla in its desert-medieval style, built on top of a city from Roman times. Mut, the center of Dakhla is still using its Ancient Egyptian name after the goddess of Waset (Luxor), and here further visits will take you to the "Temple of the Rock" and the Colored Mountain. Then we will visit Mozawaka Tombs, one of the most famous and beautiful colored Tombs in all oases. After visiting this beautiful site, we will drive you to Balat village to visit the Mastaba tomb, then drive back to the hotel. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 9 - Dakhla & Kharga

After breakfast, accompanied by your private guide, we will start our drive towards the last oasis for our desert journey. This is the Kharga Oasis, the center for the Governorate of Wadi Gedid - a Governorate responsible for 40 percent of Egypt's land area where artifacts from the whole of Wadi Gedid's Ancient Egyptian, Christian, and Islamic periods are exhibited.

The Amon temple in Hibis is one of the only two temples known built during the Persian rule of Egypt (26th Dynasty). The inscriptions on the later-built Roman gate give a very important understanding of Roman imperial rule in Egypt. After Christianity came to Egypt with St. Mark the Evangelist, the Christian community was in periods under hard prosecution from Roman rule with thousands and thousands of martyrs. Many fled to the desert for protection. Kharga was one of these places, and the result of this is that we in Bahariya got one of the oldest and best-preserved Christian cemeteries in the world.

On top of a hill close to Hibis lies the Roman temple-fortress Nadura, a typical lookout as the English House visited in Baharia - apart from the fact that Nadura was built nearly two thousand years earlier. Then drive you to the hotel. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 10 - The Kharga Oasis - Luxor

After breakfast, drive to Luxor (It will take around 5 hours of driving). Arrive Luxor and transfer to your hotel for overnight.



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Day 11 – Nile Cruise

After breakfast, our representative will transfer you to your Nile cruise. Have lunch on board.

After lunch, you will visit Karnak Temple, called by some “the Temple of Temples.” It is the largest place of worship ever built. Within the complex, the great “Hypostyle Hall” is an incredible forest of giant pillars covering an area larger than the whole of Notre Dame Cathedral. Return to your cruise.

In the evening, a Horse carriage ride around the Cornish of Luxor, then passing by the Sphinx Road, the local market, and having the opportunity for photos in front of the Lighten Luxor Temple from outside.

Back to the cruise for dinner and overnight on board.



Day 12 – Nile Cruise

After breakfast, cross to the West Bank of the Nile and visit the wondrous Valley of the Kings, a vast city of the dead where the magnificent tombs of 62 pharaohs have been discovered. The tombs were carved deep into the desert rock, richly decorated, and filled with treasures for the afterlife of the pharaohs. Visit several of the tombs. Next, visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. This beautiful monument to the reign of the only female pharaoh rises out of the desert plain in a series of terraces and merges with the sheer limestone cliffs surrounding it.

On the way back to your Nile cruise, stop at the famed Colossi of Memnon, two 66ft, 1-thousand-ton statues of Amenhotep III. Return to your cruise for lunch. Sail to Edfu. Have dinner on board. Overnight at Edfu.



Day 13 – Nile Cruise

After breakfast on board, set out by horse-drawn carriage to visit the Temple of Horus, the most perfectly preserved of all the Nile Temples. Horus, also known as Haroeris, was the falcon-headed solar war god. Return to your cruise vessel by carriage and sail to Kom Ombo.

Have lunch on board. Visit the Temple of Sobek, the crocodile-headed god of fertility and creator of the world. The temple stands at a bend in the Nile where, in ancient times, sacred crocodiles basked in the sun on the riverbank.

Have dinner and overnight on board. Sail to Aswan overnight.



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Day 14 – Nile Cruise

After breakfast on board, take a short motorboat ride to the Temple of Philae on the island of Anguilla. The temple was dedicated to Isis, sister/wife of Osiris and patroness of the Ptolemaic rule.

Lunch on your cruise.

Dinner and overnight on board of your cruise in Aswan.

Day 15 – Cairo

After breakfast, you will disembark from the cruise and transfer to Aswan Airport for your flight to Cairo.

(Optional: You can fly to Abu Simbel and visit the temples built over a 25-year span, one of Egypt's most prodigious feats of engineering. The entire complex of temples was moved to its present location 90 feet above its old site to protect it from the rising water of the Nile when the Aswan Dam was built in the early sixties. Fly back to Aswan and connect to your flight to Cairo.)

Upon arrival at Cairo Airport, you will meet our representative and be transferred to your hotel overnight.

Tonight, you will experience our special farewell. Your private transfer man and driver will pick you up. Drive to downtown Cairo and start walking through its streets, enjoying the amazing and beautiful buildings with special European architecture. Enjoy tasting Egyptian cuisine by sampling well-known dishes like Koshari (rice, pasta, lentil, fried onion), foul and falafel, and shawarma. Sip sugar cane juice while taking a stroll through the streets of Cairo. Later, you will be transferred to the pier. Get on the most traditional Egyptian boat known as Felucca and enjoy a relaxing experience of a Felucca ride along the Nile River, where you can discover the amazing nightlife of Cairo. After the ride is finished, you will transfer back to your hotel.

Day 16 - Departure Flight

You will be transferred to the airport for your departure flight.
